





OPEN WATER - THE ADVENTURE BEGINS!

Getting certified is easier than you think. There are three parts to the course:

Knowledge Development

PADI's on-line course makes learning the principles of SCUBA diving fun. Another option is to review the Open Water Manual and DVD.

Confined Water Skills

In the comfort and security of a swimming pool, you will learn how to use SCUBA gear and how to perform the skills necessary to dive safely.

Open Water Certification Dives

You will perform the skills you learned in the pool out in open water. We will do four (4) dives over the course of two (2) days.

Scheduling: We schedule the classes around your needs; evening and weekend classes are available. Generally students need a week or two to review the knowledge development and 8-10 hours in the pool to master the skills. Once the knowledge development and confined water skills are complete, then we go to Open Water which can be completed in one weekend

Requirements:

- Students must be at least 10 years of age
- Students must be able to swim 200 yards (any stroke) and float and/or tread water for 10 minutes
